1.1 What is Autodesk Factory Design Suite 2012?

Autodesk® Factory Design Suite 2012 is a 2D & 3D factory layout and optimization solution that helps you make better layout decisions by creating a digital model of your factory.

It provides tools for optimizing 2D layouts for efficient material flow, integrating 2D layout data with 3D models of machine and facility components, and 3D factory-specific visualization and analysis to help teams make better layout decisions before any equipment is installed.

Only Factory Design Suite offers unique factory-specific functionality in AutoCAD and Autodesk Inventor and combines them with powerful visualization and analysis tools that can help foster greater collaboration, flexibility, and innovation when responding to changing business requirements

- **2D and 3D visual layout environment**—Easily try “what-if” scenarios by dragging and dropping 3D models of machine and facilities content on top of your 2D floor plan.

- **Large library of Factory assets**—Access out-of-the-box 2D, and 3D parametric, Factory content such as conveyors, material handling equipment, and facility equipment that can be resized and reused.
- **Factory asset builder**—Use Autodesk Inventor software to create 3D models of Factory equipment, or easily import Factory assets from suppliers to include in your layout.
- **Factory design efficiency**—Improve your digital Factory design efficiency by automating manual repetitive tasks such as creation of plan views and section views of the layout, and save time on tape measurements by leveraging laser scanning in your layout workflows.
- **3D Factory visualization and analysis**—Collaborate better with immersive high-quality renderings and visualizations and explore digital Factory layouts with interactive 3D virtual walk-throughs and fly-throughs.

3. Installation, Configuration, and Licensing

3.1 Is the Factory Design Suite available as a standalone and network license?

Yes, Autodesk Factory Design Suite is available for both stand-alone and network licensing. Licensing is handled through standard Autodesk licensing processes using Autodesk Licensing Manager (ADLM). Customers who purchase multiple network licenses for suites that have common products and are only able to access a subset of prior version copies can get their full prior version entitlement by contacting their reseller or visiting <https://registeronce.autodesk.com> to have the licenses reissued.

3.2 Do all products in the Factory Design Suite need to be used on the same workstation?

Yes, the software applications within an Autodesk Factory Design Suite license can only be installed on a single computer. They cannot be split across multiple workstations.

3.3 How do I activate my software?

Through the activation and registration interface, you can activate 24 hours a day, seven days a week, over the Internet or via email. Either option takes only a few steps to complete and requires your serial number and registration information.

3.4 What if I have more than one computer? Can I use my software on multiple machines?

Autodesk recognizes that some users may need to operate the software when they are away from their usual work location. To accommodate this need, the product activation technology allows an employee to install the software on a second computer owned by the employee's company, provided it is for use away from the employee's usual work location, the software is used only by that employee and no other, and only one of the two copies of the software is ever in use at any one time. Consult the Autodesk Software License Agreement for details about using the software on a second computer.

- Ability to add smart connection points and landing surface definitions on the asset
- Automatically convert 2D drawings into 3D layouts
